2021 Local Government By-Election

Instructions (PLEASE PRINT)

1. Complete this form and mail, email, or deliver to the Chief Elections Officer, 2nd Floor, Suite 101, 310 Ward Street, Nelson, BC, V1L 5S4, email: elections@nelson.ca, as soon as possible. The form must be received by City Elections staff no later than **4pm March 10, 2021** in order for you to receive a mail ballot (if you qualify).
2. If your application is complete and you qualify to vote by mail, the Chief Elections Officer will send you a mail ballot package as soon as possible following the official Declaration of the By-Election.
3. You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot is received in the Administration Department or in the drop-box located outside City Hall **by 4pm on Friday, March 26, 2021 (preferred) or** if necessary, at the Prestige Lakeside Resort **on General Voting Day, Saturday, March 27, 2021**, no later than 8 pm, close for voting.

And request that I receive a ballot to vote by mail, under the provisions of Section 110 of the *Local Government Act*, for the Local Government By-Election to be held on Saturday, March 27, 2021.

To be eligible to vote in the by-election you must be:

- 18 years of age or older on March 27, 2021; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of the City of Nelson for at least the past 30 days OR a non-resident registered owner of real property in the City of Nelson for at least the past 30 days; and
- a resident of BC for at least the past 6 months; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in a by-election and not otherwise disqualified by law.
