The Nelson Public Library is currently accepting applications for Summer Reading Club Coordinators. Reporting to the Children's Librarian, the Summer Reading Club Coordinators will plan, promote, and deliver the library's annual Summer Reading Club, which this year will most likely take place online/outdoors depending on provincial COVID restrictions.

This is a temporary, full-time position working from June 21, 2021 to August 13, 2021, Monday through Friday 9:00am to 3:30pm, 30 hours per week. The rate of pay is \$15.50 per hour.

The Summer Reading Club Coordinators will organize and deliver daily activities and programs for children ages 6-12. This will include reading, crafts, games, storytelling, songs, puppetry, drama, etc.
