# NOTICE OF NOMINATION

PUBLIC NOTICE is given to the electors of the City of Nelson that nominations for the office of Mayor, Councillor and School Trustee will be received at the Administration Office, City of Nelson, 310 Ward Street, Nelson, BC between the hours of 9:00 am on Tuesday, October 4th, 2011 and 4:00 pm on Friday, October 14th, 2011.

Representation for Council and School Trustee will be as listed below:

**One Position for MAYOR**

**Six Positions for COUNCILLOR**

**Two Positions for SCHOOL TRUSTEE**

The mode of nominations for candidates shall be as follows:

Candidates shall be nominated in writing by two duly qualified electors of the City of Nelson or for School Trustee of Electoral area 1 of School District No. 8.

Nominations for qualified candidates will be received during the following times at the office of the Chief Election Officer, City Hall, 2nd Floor, 310 Ward Street, Nelson, BC, from:

9:00 am to 4:30 pm on Tuesday, October 4th, 2011

8:30 am to 4:30 pm on Wednesday to Friday, October 5th to 7th, 2011

8:30 am to 4:30 pm on Tuesday to Thursday, October 11th to 13th, 2011

8:30 am to 4:00 pm on Friday, October 14th, 2011

The nomination documents shall be in the form prescribed in the Local Government Act and shall state the name and residence of the person nominated in such a manner as to sufficiently identify that person. The nomination documents shall be subscribed to by the candidate.

At the time of filing the nomination documents, the candidate shall also file with the Chief Election Officer or designate, a written disclosure, as required under the Financial Disclosure Act.

NOMINATION PACKAGES, CONTAINING ALL RELEVANT FORMS, ARE AVAILABLE AT City Hall during regular office hours from this date until October 14th, 2011.
