NELSON HYDRO COVID-19 RELIEF PROGRAM APPLICATION

On May 13, 2020, Nelson Hydro filed an application with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) for its COVID-19 Relief Program (Application) for customers affected by COVID-19 pandemic. The Application seeks approval to temporarily suspend the existing late-payment penalty for any amounts owed from May 4, 2020 to June 30, 2020.

Nelson Hydro is owned and operated by the City of Nelson and is exempt from regulation under the *Utilities Commission Act* when serving customers within its municipal boundaries. As Nelson Hydro also serves customers outside its municipal boundaries, the BCUC's review of the Application only relates to Nelson Hydro's non-municipal, or rural, ratepayers.
