



The City of Nelson WATER QUALITY ADVISORY

This Water Quality Advisory is effective May 03 2023 until further notice

The Interior Health Authority in consultation with The City of Nelson is issuing a **water quality advisory** for the water distribution system within the City boundary. Due to current spring run-off conditions, ongoing testing indicates an increased level of turbidity or suspended matter in the drinking water supply.

This water is consumable however, The Interior Health Authority recommends that people with compromised immune systems or anyone seeking additional protection, should take pre-cautions when drinking, washing fruits & vegetables, making beverages or brushing teeth.

Customers may choose to:

1. Bring water to a rolling boil for at least 1 minute before consuming
2. Use an alternate source or bottled water
