

The City of Nelson WATER QUALITY ADVISORY RESCINDED

The Water Quality Advisory issued May 03 2023 is RESCINDED

After consultation with The Interior Health Authority, the water quality advisory issued on May 3, 2023 due to spring run-off conditions and increased levels of turbidity or suspended matter in the drinking water supply is now rescinded.

Ongoing testing indicates that the current water quality in the Nelson drinking water supply is now GOOD. The elevated turbidity in our source water, resulting from spring freshet has decreased to a level where water quality is no longer degraded.

The City continues to monitor water quality at our source and throughout our system however, a significant amount of high mountain snowpack remains to melt. Should water quality change, we will post any future notices on the City's website, through social media and radio and via notices where necessary.
